Rydens Enterprise School

OVERVIEW

The pitched roof to the Gymnasium and the flat roofs to the adjoining Administration and Teaching Blocks were in a poor state of repair. Historic roof leaks had damaged internal finishes to the flat roof areas.

Chawton Hill were appointed by the school to complete a building condition survey and then act as principal designers and project managers.



About the School

The Three Rivers Academy (formerly Rydens Enterprise School and Sixth Form College) is a mixed, secondary school situated on Hersham Road, between Hersham and Walton-on-Thames in Surrey, England. The school has been awarded Specialist Business and Enterprise College status.

Outcomes

The roofing replacement project encompassed the removal of the existing tiles and the flat roof finishing materials.

The roofs were re-covered with Redland roof tiles to the pitched areas and high performance felt to the flat roof areas. Insulation was added to all of the roof areas.
